AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE PLAN, STREETS AND ALLEYS OF THE PLAN OF LOTS LAID OUT BY JULIA AIMES, DENOMINATED AS THE NEWKIRK PLAN OF LOTS, IN THE BOROUGH OF BENTLEYVILLE, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, Julia Aimes, the owner of a certain tract of land lying in the Borough of Bentleyville, Washington County, Pennsylvania, laid out thereon a Plan of Lots known as the "Newkirk Plan of Lots, which plan was recorded on August 14th, 1905, in the Recorder's Office of said County in Plan Book 3, page 78, on which certain streets and alleys were laid out and dedicated to public use; therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Bentleyville, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same that the said Plan of Lots, known as the "Newkirk Plan of Lots", as laid out by Julia Aimes, and of record in the Recorder's Office of said County in Plan Book 3, page 78, together with all streets, lanes, roads and alleys as therein designated and laid out, be and the same is hereby adopted as a part of the plan of the said Borough, and the streets, lanes, roads and alleys, as therein designated, shall become streets, lanes, roads and alleys of the said Borough.
