## AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING AND ADOPTING, AS A PUBLIC STREET, A STREET EXTENDING FROM MAIN STREET, AT A STREET LEADING THROUGH THE J. E. RICHARDSON PLAN OF LOTS, TO A PUBLIC ROAD, IN BENT-LEYVILLE BOROUGH, KNOWN AS THE "WASHINGTON ROAD", AND APPROVING THE PLAN AS ADOPTED BY THE OWNERS OF PROPERTIES CROSSED BY THE SAID STREET.

WHEREAS, A certain street leading from Main

Street, in the said Borough of Bentleyville, to the Washington Road, has been laid out and dedicated to public use
by I. Abromitis, Crouch heirs,

and thereof has
been made by the owners of the properties traversed by the
said street, which plan has been adopted by them, and is
to be recorded; and,

WHEREAS, The said plan has been presented to the Council and Burgess, with the request that the said plan be approved and the street, so laid out and dedicated to public use, be adopted as a public street of the said Borough; Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED By the Burgess and
Town Council of the Borough of Bentleyville, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:-

SECTION I. That the street, the center line of which begins at the intersection of the Northern line of Main Street, formerly known as the Ellsworth and Bentley-

ville Road, at a point 25 feet Eastwardly at right angles from the Easterly margin of a street leading out of the said Main Street through the J. E. Richardson Plan of Lots, and running from then North 14° 51-1/2' West, 962.13 feet; thence North 10° 53-1/2' East, 35.95 feet to the division line between the lands of I. Abromitis and C. K. Frye, et al.; thence continuing North 10° 53-1/2' East, 381.73 feet; thence North 79° 3-1/2' West, 186.02 feet; thence North 21° 4-1/2' West, 503.71 feet; thence North 29° 9' West, 20.2 feet to division line between the lands of C. K. Frye, et al., and J. M. Crouch, et al.; thence continuing through said Crouch land, North 29° 9' West, 638.78 feet; thence North 60 1' East, 547.13 feet to the intersection with the Southerly line of a public road known as the Washington Road, the total length of the center line of said street being 3275.65 feet, and of the width as shown on the plan hereinabove referred to, be, and the same is hereby, upon the recording of the plan above mentioned, accepted and adopted as a public street of the said Borough, and the plan herein above referred to is hereby approved.

SECTION II. That the Burgess of the said Borough be, and is hereby, authorized to place upon the said plan the approval thereof by the Borough of Bentleyville, under the seal of the said Borough.

SECTION III. That the said street, so located and dedicated, shall be open to public travel at such time hereafter, and upon such terms as the Council of the said Borough shall designate.

SECTION IV. All ordinances, rules and regulations in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, be, and the same are hereby, repealed, in so far as the same conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.
