AN ORDINANCE

PROHIBITING BREACHES OF THE PEACE, RIOTOUS OR DISORDERLY CONDUCT, TENDING TO A BREACH OF THE PEACE, AND THE COMMISSION OF UNLAWFUL ACTS, TENDING TO IMPERIL THE PERSONAL SECURITY, OR TO ENDANGER THE PROPERTY OF CITIZENS IN THE BOROUGH OF BENTLEYVILLE, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPREHENDING, FINING OR COMMITTING OF ALL PERSONS FOUND GUILTY OF SUCH OFFENSES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED By the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Bentleyville, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION I. That indecent and improper conduct, tending to debauch the public morals and violate common public decency, and conduct which is disorderly, loud and boisterous to the disturbance of the peace and good order of the Borough of Bentleyville, or the engaging in quarreling, fighting, or doing other acts whereby the peace and good order of the said Borough is disturbed, or engaging in the commission of any unlawful act, tending to imperil the personal security or endanger the property of the citizens of said Borough, or intoxication upon the public streets, roads and highways in the said Borough, or the use of profane or vile language thereon, to the annoyance and disturbance of the good and orderly citizens in said Borough, are hereby prohibited; and the commission by any person or persons of the acts or conduct hereinabove prohibited shall be deemed a violation of the provisions of this ordinance, and such

offender or offenders shall, upon conviction thereof before
the Burgess or any Justice of the Peace in the said Borough,
be fined not less than Two (2) Dollars nor more than One
Hundred (100) Dollars, and be subject to the payment of the
costs of suit, and in default of the payment of such fine or
penalty imposed, and costs, the defendant may be sentenced
and committed to the Borough lock-up for a period not exceeding five days, or to the County Jail for a period not
exceeding thirty days.
